

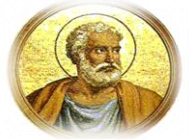

<b>Saturday 14<sup>th</sup></b> 6:00pm	Mass – Fr David Maskell RIP	<b>THE REPAIR OF THE KNEELERS, THE PUGIN FAMILY AND OUR CHURCH</b> As you will see the kneelers have been removed for a much-needed restoration. The work is being undertaken by Ormsby from Scarisbrick, in Lancashire. As you know we are trying to stimulate a parish awareness of our historical relationship with the architect of our church, Augustus Pugin. The coincidental choice of this repair firm for the kneelers has highlighted yet another obscure connection with this influential 19 <sup>th</sup> century architect and designer. Scarisbrick Hall which is now a school was the family seat of the Scarisbrick family, a recusant family throughout the post reformation period. Whilst not as brash a Catholic as Augustus Pugin, Charles Scarisbrick struck up a relationship with Pugin that lasted half his lifetime. The consequence of this relationship at Scarisbrick Hall can still be seen today in what is regarded as one of the finest examples of Victorian Gothic architecture in the country. Ironically Pugin tried to get Charles Scarisbrick to install a tower with a clock that was the precursor to what eventually became Big Ben, some 15 years later. Scarisbrick was a taciturn individual not given to such ostentatious displays of open grandeur, although he was a serious connoisseur of antiquaries and a well-known collector of such items. Charles Scarisbrick resisted Pugin's suggestion to build the tower but another link arose as his sister who inherited the estate after his death, and Pugin's son Edward, did build a tower at Scarisbrick Hall. This can still be seen today and bears not a dissimilar resemblance to the Big Ben tower. The kneelers are not only in the safe possession of a skilled set of craftsmen they are also entrusted to a family in an area with a direct link to the architect that built St Peter the Apostle in Woolwich in 1842 and his son who built Pugin Place in 1858.
