FROM ARCHBISHOP JOHN WILSON'S DESK:

As we approach the great celebration of the Most Holy Trinity, what an incredible, mind blowing truth it is that we, poor as we are, share in the very life of God. With all our challenges, both personal and in our ministry, we are granted access to the relationship of love between the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The Catechism of the Catholic Church puts this beautifully when it says: '...even now we are called to be a dwelling for the Most Holy Trinity: 'If a man loves me', says the Lord, 'he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him, and make our home with him.' (CCC 260) What we know to be true about God is revealed by God sending His Son, by the Son revealing the Father, and the Father and the Son sending the Holy Spirit. We are the dwelling place of the Most High God. God's life is within us. We are caught up into the circle of love between the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

That God's life might grow within us, is captured in the ancient Christian greeting: 'The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.' I pray that this Trinity Sunday your sense of God's indwelling in your heart, your experience of God's loving relationship, might strengthen and encourage you in your ministry of service.

St Elizabeth of the Trinity wrote a prayer expressing something of what this means:

O my God, Trinity whom I adore, help me forget myself entirely so to establish myself in you, unmovable and peaceful as if my soul were already in eternity. May nothing be able to trouble my peace or make me leave you, O my unchanging God, but may each minute bring me more deeply into your mystery! Grant my soul peace. Make it your heaven, your beloved dwelling and the place of your rest. May I never abandon you there, but may I be there, whole and entire, completely vigilant in my faith, entirely adoring, and wholly given over to your creative action. Amen


