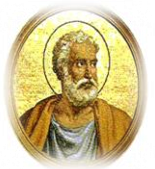

Nevertheless, there will be an encouragement to personal and corporate responsibility in this area; as the Prime Minister said in his most recent statement “The pandemic is not over.” Even without this legislation in place, the Church in England and Wales will be adopting a cautious approach to capacity and activity within our buildings, especially at corporate acts of worship.</p> <p>Recommended Key Mitigating Actions against Virus Transmission in Churches which should continue post 19th July 2021 include the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sanitising hands on entry to churches and before liturgies as in current church guidance reduces risk; • Ensuring people wear face coverings properly will reduce aerosol or droplet spread; • Ventilating buildings well remains important; • Maintaining a good general standard of routine cleaning using usual cleaning detergents is sufficient for regular use; • It is recommended that Holy Water stoups are NOT refilled; • It is recommended that the physical Sign of Peace remain suspended; • Holy Communion will continue to be under one kind and the ministers will continue to sanitise their hands beforehand and wear a face covering whilst distributing. Communion is recommended to be distributed in the hand but those who wish to receive on the tongue may do so at the end.

ACT OF PERFECT CONTRITION

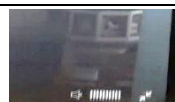
