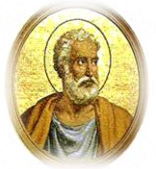

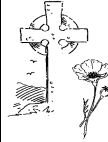

**RCIA FOR ADULTS**

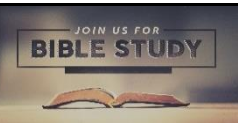
