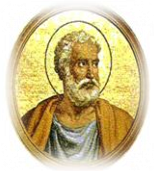

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

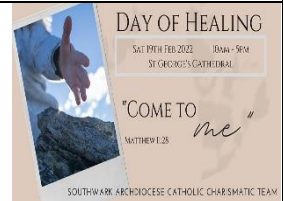
To baptise your child please see the priest or phone the Parish Office to arrange a date and time of baptism.

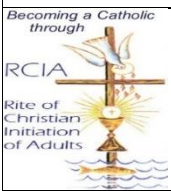
