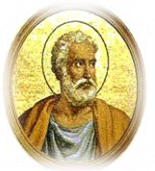

Saturday 10th 6:00pm	Holy Mass – Theresa Hedges RIP	THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI) (A) The feast of Corpus Christi, also known as the Body and Blood of Christ is a celebration of the real presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist. It is a celebration of Jesus' gift of himself to the Church. Luke 22: 19, 'This is my body', and 'this is my blood.' Jesus earlier in John 6 told his disciples, 'Unless you eat the flesh of the son of man and drink his blood, you have no life in you...my flesh is real food, and my blood real drink.' The Church has continued to celebrate the Eucharist in obedience to the command of Jesus, 'Do this in remembrance of me.' The Holy Eucharist is the true body and blood, soul, and divinity of Jesus Christ under the appearances of bread and wine. When a Catholic priest within the celebration of Holy Mass utters the words of consecration over the bread and wine, the species change into the body and blood of Christ. This change is called, 'Transubstantiation.' Which means that though the appearances of bread and wine remain, the substance is changed instantaneously. Let us therefore always recognise and adore Jesus in the Holy Eucharist by attending Mass regularly, receiving the sacrament with reverence, and adore Jesus during Benediction or Exposition.

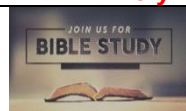
SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM
