

#### **CHRISTMAS ENVELOPES**

The Christmas Envelopes are used for the collection at Masses for Christmas Day, which is the traditional 'Thank You' collection by parishioners to the priests of their parish for their work and service. Priests here receive no salary whatsoever for their work and depend on the generosity of parishioners for sustenance. The money in the Christmas Envelopes and the collection on Christmas Day will be shared equally by the clergy. Please note that those of you in the parish GIFT AID SCHEME should use your Gift Aid envelopes for the Christmas Collection and hand this in. The priests will get your offering and the Parish will benefit from the tax refund on your offerina.

#### CHRISTMAS MESSAGE

Jesus Christ came to us more than 2000 years ago. With his promise, we expect him to come again for the second time. Yet, in actual fact, Jesus comes to us every single day of our life. For that reason, Jesus expects us to welcome HIM. Jesus expects us to be open in mind and heart to welcome him this special season. The grace of welcoming Jesus is the greatest form of gift because we allow him to influence our lifestyle. Meaning our life choices would reflect our intimate friendship with Jesus Christ, this would also imply that our values are identical with the teachings of Jesus Christ.
